



Request & Authorization to Remove Joint Owner(s)

Ownership Change Requirements:

Account at Susquehanna Valley Federal Credit Union (SVFCU) must be in good standing before any owner(s) on the account can be removed.

Original signatures are required; facsimiles will not be accepted for changes to joint ownership.

If any joint loans or Visa credit cards are outstanding on the account, the Joint Owner may NOT be removed until the loan(s) and/or Visa credit card obligations have been paid in full or refinanced to remove the Joint Owner(s) as cosigner, coborrower, or authorized user.

To remove a deceased Joint Owner's name, please provide an original Death Certificate and complete a new Membership Application.
